

Mango Garden Quilt

(Night blue colourway)

This gorgeous night blue version of the quilt is made in exactly the same way as the dove white one, except for the background colour. Follow the Materials list below and to see how the night blue colourway looks, refer to Fig A, Fig B and Fig C for the swatches, layout and quilt sections. See Dove White version for full explanation.

- Fabric 1: 5¹/₂yds (5m) Solid night blue (120029)
- Fabric 2*: 12in x 27in (30.5cm x 68.6cm) Late Bloomer tomato (100501)
- Fabric 3*: 6in x 20in (15.2cm x 50.8cm) Flowermarket plum (100502)
- Fabric 4: 4¹/₂in x 18in (11.4cm x 45.7cm) Cottonbloom paprika (100503)
- Fabric 5*: one fat eighth (not a long ¹/₈yd) Garden Vista iris (100504)
- Fabric 6*: one fat eighth (*not* a long ½yd) Flowertangle persimmon (100505)
- Fabric 7*: 6in x 20in (15.2cm x 50.8cm) Flowermarket blueberry (100506)
- Fabric 8*: one fat eighth (not a long 1/8yd) Garden Vista dove (100507)
- Fabric 9*: 6in x 27in (15.2cm x 68.6cm) Late Bloomer sapphire (100508)
- Fabric 10*: 9in (23cm) square Flowertangle blue (100509)
- Fabric 11: 4¹/₂in x 18in (11.4cm x 45.7cm) Cottonbloom blueberry (100510)
- Fabric 12*: 6in x 27in (15.2cm x 68.6cm) Late Bloomer lagoon (100511)
- Fabric 13*: ³/₈yd (40cm) Flowertangle green (100512)

- Fabric 18*: 6in x 20in (15.2cm x 50.8cm) Flowermarket sky (100517)
- Fabric 19*: one fat eighth (not a long ¹/₈yd) Garden Vista light corn (100518)
- Fabric 20: 4¹/₂in x 18in (11.4cm x 45.7cm) Cottonbloom sky (100519)
- Fabric 21*: 6in x 27in (15.2cm x 68.6cm) Late Bloomer corn (100520)
- Fabric 22: 12in (30.5cm) square Abloom turquoise (110072)
- Fabric 23: 9in (23cm) square Abloom sky (110074)
- Fabric 24: ³/₈yd (40cm) Abloom cornflower (110075)
- Fabric 25: ¹/₄yd (25cm) or fat quarter Abloom iris (110077)
- Fabric 26: 9in (23cm) square Abloom tomato (110079)
- Fabric 27: 12in (30.5cm) square Abloom pink (110080)
- Fabric 28: ³/₈yd (40cm) Abloom dijon (110081)
- Fabric 29: 9in (23cm) square Abloom fern (110082)
- Fabric 30: ¹/₄yd (25cm) or fat quarter Abloom mushroom (110083)
- Fabric 31: 12in (30.5cm) square Solid coral (120016)
- Fabric 32: 12in (30.5cm) square Solid dijon (120039)
- Fabric 33: 12in (30.5cm) square Solid dusty teal (120043)
- Fabric 34: 12in (30.5cm) square Solid cornflower blue (120024)
- Wadding (batting): 74in x 92in (188cm x 234cm)
- Backing fabric: 5¹/₄yds (4.8m) Abloom plum (110078)

- Binding fabric: ⁵/₈yd (60cm) Solid night blue (120029)
- Piecing and quilting threads
- Quilter's ruler, rotary cutter and mat
- Black embroidery cotton (floss) for French knot eyes

Fabric Notes

The Solid fabrics can be cut vertically or horizontally. However, many of the print fabrics have a directional pattern, so take care when cutting to preserve the direction of motifs. Fabrics marked with an asterisk (*) in the Materials list are those where fussy cutting was used to select attractive motifs, so additional material is suggested. A fat eighth is assumed to be approximately $10\frac{1}{2}$ in x 18in (26.7cm x 45.7cm) and a fat quarter approximately 21in x 18in (53.3cm x 45.7cm).

Finished Size

65¹/₂in x 83¹/₂in (16.5cm x 212cm)

General Notes

- Fabric quantities are based on a usable width of 42in (107cm), unless otherwise stated.
- Measurements are in imperial inches with metric conversions in brackets use only *one* system throughout (preferably inches). Width measurements are generally given first.
- Before using your fabrics, press before cutting and trim as needed to square up the fabric pattern/weave, using a quilting ruler to cut the top raw edge at 90 degrees to the selvedges.
- Use ¹/₄in (6mm) seams unless otherwise instructed.
- Read all the instructions through before you start.
- Always make one section as a test before going on to make the remaining blocks.

Quilt Layout

1 The quilt layout is exactly the same as the dove white version. The three diagrams below show how the quilt looks with a night blue background – Fig A for the fabrics used, Fig B for the quilt layout and Fig C for the sections that make up the quilt.

Making the Quilt

2 Follow all of the instructions given for the dove white version of the quilt but substituting night blue for the background.

Quilting and Finishing

3 To quilt and finish off, follow the instructions given for the dove white version of the quilt.
